WHEREAS, The Boy Scouts of America (BSA) and Chester County Council place the greatest importance on creating the most secure environment possible for our youth members, and

WHEREAS, Youth Protection training is an important educational tool in creating this environment and is a requirement for registration with the BSA, and

WHEREAS, the BSA recognizes Youth Protection training to be valid for 24 months from the completion date and a volunteer's Youth Protection training record must be valid at the time of recharter in order to be reregistered, and

WHEREAS, the BSA policy can result in a number of volunteers' Youth Protection training expiring during the year with continuous follow up throughout the year required to identify and attempt to renew these volunteers' training.

WE NOW THEREFORE, RESOLVE that the Executive Board of the Chester County Council, Boy Scouts of America has agreed, upon a motion duly made, and approved this sixth day of August, 2014, to require all Chester County Council volunteers and staff to have Youth Protection training valid through the last day of the recharter period in order to reregister (resulting in Youth Protection training needing to be completed every year rather than every other year), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Chester County Council will promote October as "Youth Protection month" and encourage all volunteers and staff to renew their Youth Protection training annually during this month.
